Our fiscal year starts on the 1st of July and ends on 30th of June. Obviously a good year for our investments and quite likely upsetting to the Northwestern University professor and the others that have predicted the demise of our pension fund by 2018. Our overall funded status improved from just over 40% to approximately 46%. A long way to go to full funding and the * is to remind us that most of the money received from the State last year was borrowed with a eight year loan that the State is paying both the principle and the interest. This year the State will pay about \$2.4 billion to TRS, approximately \$200 million a month. As of the end of October, the pension fund has received \$520 million out of the \$800 million due. Note the significant contribution from active teachers to your pension.

VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

Tutors are needed for Read to Learn, an one-to-one adult literacy program administered through District 214 Community Education. Students are primarily recent immigrants, 18 or older, with limited English proficiency. They are wonderful to work with and extremely appreciative of the time the tutors donate. To enroll in Read to Learn, students must test at a basic English proficiency level and may not exceed an eighth grade reading comprehension level. There are eleven different sites throughout the area with classes scheduled Mon. - Sat. in the morning, afternoon and evening so tutors can find a site that would fit their schedule. Each session is ten weeks long; dates vary with site availability. Each week, a site supervisor will provide the tutor with materials appropriate to the student's tested reading level.

Since the Read to Learn program is funded by the Illinois State Literacy Office, 10 hours of training is required to be a volunteer. (I know how ridiculous it seems to require retired teachers to receive training to tutor since many of you have spent years working with ESL students, but such is the state bureaucracy with which we're all too familiar.) Training for the spring semester will be from 8:30 - 3:30 on either Fri., Jan. 27 or Sat., Jan 28. To fulfill the remaining three hours of the state's requirement, new tutors report to their site one-half hour early during their first semester of tutoring. Once trained, you are (unless the law changes) good for life. To sign up for a Jan. training date, call the Read to Learn office at 847-718-7724.
