## **Bob Lyons' TRS Report:**



Personally, I find it difficult to believe that with all that has transpired in this last year that the financial markets and our pension fund have done so remarkably well. It is very real proof of the old adage that the rich simply get richer. Fortunately for us, the combined wealth of our pension fund can easily be counted as rich. At the end of March, 2020 TRS had \$48.6 billion, but nine months later at the end of 2020 TRS had \$57.3 billion, which represented a record amount for our fund. It also represented a growth of 17.9% from the lowest point during the year. As the financial markets continued to prosper by the end of this past February, our investments totaled \$58.3 billion, which of course was still another record for our

fund. Significantly at the end of last year the forty-year record for TRS was an annually growth rate of 9.3 percent.

I am sure that all of you understand that what TRS pays out every year is greater that what it receives in contributions. Last year, in benefits to those of us retired, survivor benefits, and in disability payments, the total paid was \$7.1 billion. A good year of investment returns allows those benefits to be paid, but also for the fund to continue to grow.

Larry Pfeiffer, who took my place on the TRS Board, will complete his first four-year term this summer. He was the only annuitant that with the backing of the Illinois Retired Teachers' Association was able to gain the minimum 500 signatures of retired teachers to run for another term. With only one authorized candidate, Trustee Pfeiffer, was declared the winner and no election was necessary, which spared TRS the cost of the contest. I think Larry has been an excellent board member and I certainly believe that




